What recently happened

- Out of 300 young applicants, 6 have been selected after intensive workshops to form the team of the new Youth News Format
- The 6 finals have received training on moderation, reporting, production
- Workshop on format development, current Jordanian news assessment and target group needs conducted by DW Akademie consultant for the young team
- First episodes of "Shabab News" broadcasted and online: <u>link</u>

Coming next

- Constant development of Shabab News concept to ensure that general news are presented in a way that is appealing to the young target group
- Mid April: End of First Season. Mid May: Start of second season

What recently happened

- Project start delayed due to approval procedure of the Jordanian Authorities
- Publication of Call for Applications in November and selection of 150 applicants to be interviewed for choosing 50 finalists

Coming next

- Organisation of orientation session for the 50 young participants
- Training of participants on the principles of film production
- Formation of 6 production teams who will elaborate ideas and concepts for the Alchemist episodes to be broadcasted on Youtube: <u>link</u>

What recently happened

- Youth steering committee created : 6 members providing feedback on topics selection to address the problems and needs of young Palestinians
- 1st episode of "Shabab Café" on drug misuse and youth unemployment with deputy prime minister of Labour, local police authority, guests from a local youth committee and a social worker who works with young drug victims: <u>link</u>
- Support from DW Consultant in the field during the production.
- 2nd episode on Education System and Labour Market in Palestine: <u>link</u>
- 3rd episode on youth representation in the local government: <u>link</u>
